Ottawa Forklift Operator Training - Lift truck training is a requirement in North America and is intended to avoid workplace injuries and death. Forklift training provides driver training intended for forklift operators. Training programs teach the safe and effective use of forklifts. Training sessions are tailored for various working environments, like enclosed stores or outdoors on a construction site. Course content includes safety protocol and everyday inspection procedures. Trainees learn the way to maneuver within a populated work environment.

When operated by an untrained individual, a lift truck can be very dangerous. To reduce the chance of accident, prospective operators must undertake forklift training by a licensed instructor prior to operating a forklift. All aspects of forklift operation are covered in training programs. The abilities and limitations of the machine are included, along with pre-operation inspections, fundamental operating procedures and methods of warning other employees that a forklift is in the work place.

The placement of chock blocks and trailer tires would be covered in the lessons, in addition to lessons on the arrangement of pallets to distribute the load right, and inspections required before driving into a trailer at a dock location. MSDS or Material Safety Data Sheet training is likewise covered in the course. Although not directly related to the utilization of a forklift, MSDS training is important if an operator damages a container containing toxic materials, or notices a leaking container. MSDS sheets list the products, their effects on people and correct ways of dealing with spills.
