For instance, a crane operator will need to take an in-depth training course and should pass various certification exams in order to become a crane operator, whereas truck drivers may only need some on the job training to go along with their CDL. The in-depth training which follows certain machine is required as a lot of the work happens in hazardous scenarios and dangerous scenes so the operator should be able to make certain of a safe working setting all the time. The safety training is essential as well as the communications training that helps the crew on the ground be able to communicate with the operator all the time.

Due to the extreme environments these equipment work under, they are usually put under incredible strain regularly. This means there are a lot of heavy machine jobs available for the maintenance and repair of the machines. Heavy machinery operators are very trained workers who could troubleshoot, repair and diagnose heavy equipment on site or in a workshop. Mechanics should be available to transport their tools to a job site and perform maintenance and repair in a variety of conditions.

It may be possible for delivery drivers to obtain work with simply a CDL, though for various jobs, certain endorsements may be needed. Like for example, delivering huge pieces of machinery or parts which are really big for construction projects will need the driver to finish further training in order to haul and handle huge loads. Usually, the drivers operate along with chaperone vehicles that are driven by drivers who are trained. These chaperone vehicles usually escort the delivery truck to its destination.
