Ottawa Order Picker License

Ottawa Order Picker License - Order picking is otherwise referred to as order preparation operation. This is amongst the key processes in a warehouse and comprises people called order pickers, taking and collecting articles in a particular quantity before shipment so as to accomplish customer orders. Order picking is a simple warehousing method. The efficiency in which this task is completed could be directly connected to the productivity of a supply chain. Hence, order picking is among the most controlled logistic processes. Order picking falls in the category of the warehouse management system.

There are several certain types of order picking. The main kinds consist of: wave picking method, pick to box method, picker to part method or piece picking, zone picking method and sorting systems method.

The pick to box method involves the order picker only filling the boxes with item which are from their specific station. The box then moves on to other locations to until the order is complete. In this process, there is no movement of the order picker workers. In the wave picking method, the order pickers move about to gather the needed products for numerous orders. The picker to part method or piece picking is similar where the order pickers move to gather the items needed but for one order only.

In the sorting systems method, there is no movement of the order picking personnel. Instead, the things are delivered to her or him through an automated system like a conveyor system or an automatic storage. In the zone picking method, every order picker is assigned to one specific zone. They are responsible for only realizing order picking within this specific zone.
