Introduction

A successful and safe warehouse operation is one that is efficient and orderly. The warehouse employee is necessary in making sure that merchandise are circulated throughout the facility in a timely and efficient method. Because of the multiple activities involved in warehouse operations, staff in warehouse settings may be at greater risk for accidents than individuals who work in areas with more limited activities. Hence, businesses place a top priority on warehouse safety.

Knowledge of possible warehouse dangers is key to preventing accidents. Always be alert to potential dangers and ways to lessen risks. Do whatever is needed to prevent accidents.

General Hazards

Common types of hazard in a warehouse setting are falls, slips and trips. These accidents are normally caused when employees lose their balance or stumble over a thing which has not been put away correctly. Removing or placing things from storage can result in a slip or fumble, possibly leading to both thing and employee to fall. The potential for trips, falls and slips is increased when staff are moving supplies on various types of floor surfaces and on various levels. Another common danger is getting hit by falling objects. This is usually caused by failure to properly stack stuff on shelves and other surfaces. Back injuries because of improper lifting techniques are another common hazard.

Warehouse equipment carries inherent dangers. Injuries or accidents can be caused by hand trucks, forklift trucks and conveyors if they are not operated properly. Warehouse tools, like for example skids, pallets, cutting and strapping tools, should be utilized carefully in loading, packing and unpacking.

Materials that are dangerous, combustible or flammable present another type of workplace danger while being stored in a warehouse. Staff must know how to take steps to protect themselves from health dangers while working around hazardous materials.
